

But that is NOT what is important! The fact is a lot of campers look good on the outside.


But the most important aspect is what lies "behind" the eye appeal.

How is the camper constructed? How a camper is built should always be the most important consideration for any buyer!

While the most popular truck topper model on the market does use aluminum, it has only a thin, flimzy, c-channel to support the bed area.



This is how they form their Radius "Structure" - by Notching their Thin Aluminum Tube and C-Channel every $\frac{1}{4}$ " so they can bend it.



Is there Weight Savings by doing this? Sure – but at what Cost? The answer to that is Structural Integrity, which is completely lost.





The OV-X uses 100% All <u>Tubular</u> **Aluminum** in our Structure for Maximum **Strength** and **Durability.**





Soaring Eagle Campers Does NOT

Cut Corners – Especially when it comes
to the Structural Integrity of our units!

Just take a closer look at this OV-X sidewall section. This is 3" Tubular Aluminum Stacked, which is both Strong AND Lightweight!





Here is a Close Up of the OV-X
Pull Out Bed Structure.

You will NOT find any plywood or other cheap materials here –

ONLY strong, tubular aluminum which will be covered with a composite sheet.

Now you see why Soaring Eagle Campers will out last your truck.





Is the Competition's Roof Lightweight? Sure, but notice the thin aluminum sheet that forms the exterior of their roof..



Thin Aluminum Skin is what cargo trailers use on their roofs. Cargo trailer mfgs. don't care that it is loud inside when it rains, because no one is sleeping in a cargo trailer. But this? This is a camper!





The sturdy, tubular aluminum-framed roof of the OV-X is fully insulated with block foam insulation and wiring is run to the roof vents and lighting which are **Standard on every** model.

This is SOLID.



The OV-X roof is covered inside and out with sturdy, seamless, one-piece fiberglass.

What about the LIFT SYSTEM?

This is one of the most important aspects of a pop-up camper!

The competition has a bulky, awkward system which incorporates large composite boards that fold up on either end of the camper and a large bar that remains over the sleeping area when the camper is in use.



This thin, composite board is what supports the weight of the roof.



This cumbersome lift system actually closes off both ends of the camper making it seem smaller than it is.



The Result is No Front or **Rear Windows** on the unit because a large board covers up each end of the camper.





We took our time and engineered a BETTER lift system for the OV-X camper





SE's State-of-the-Art Steel Bar Lift System easily lifts and locks into place, up and out of the way, allowing for Windows on both ends of the camper, which makes it feel much more open!

There is a much better way than this...







And the Soaring Eagle Campers OV-X has engineered it!



Both Front and Rear Windows on Each Model **Offer Better Air Flow and Great Views of Your Surroundings**



The Competition **Cut Corners** out of their rear door which limits the size of things you can load into the back of the truck.





NO Corners are Cut in the OV-X as we do NOT notch out of the corners of the rear door. This offers the ability to load larger items into the back of your truck like an ATV - more easily!





Let's take a look inside the Soaring Eagle Campers Production Facility











We build our rugged OV-X campers out of strong tubular aluminum; our <u>sidewalls</u> are tubular aluminum; our <u>endwalls</u> are tubular aluminum; our <u>roofs</u> are tubular aluminum; even our <u>pull-out bed structure</u> is tubular aluminum! To that we add <u>Composites</u> – but not a splinter of wood!




TRIMMING THE OV-X ROOF

Each OV-X features our custom-designed Soaring Eagle Electrical Center which is hand-crafted out of sturdy composite material. This handy set up separates us from the competition as it neatly houses the solar panel control system, 12V outlets (including USBs) and also has the light and fan switches which are easily reached from outside the camper.

Below the **Electrical Center**, the coach batteries can be easily hooked up - whatever configuration the customer may choose to house their batteries in.

It's not cheap to build a camper using all welded tubular aluminum construction instead of wood.

It's not cheap to use one-piece, seamless fiberglass on the roof instead of a thin metal covering.

It's not cheap to use composites to construct our electrical center, headboards and other features instead of wood.

It's not cheap to build our slide-out, lift-up bed structure out of tubular aluminum instead of just using plywood.
